evaluate the need for a marked crosswalk on Broadway Street between "A" Street and "B" Street to en bedestrian safety. TKE Engineering, Inc., the City's Contract Engineer, was retained to cond engineering study for crosswalk installation at this location and to perform a stop warrant analysis nearest uncontrolled intersection.	nhance uct ar
TKE Engineering performed an on-site review during school and business hours, collected collisions traffic data, and analyzed conditions in accordance with Section 2B-07 of the California Manual on Utraffic Control Devices (CA MUTCD) for Multi-Way Stop Applications.	
Based on engineering judgment and observed sight distance constraints, TKE recommends instal all-way stop and marked crosswalks at the intersection of Broadway Street and B Street. Therefor completed a plan for the installation of the appropriate signage and striping.	
Cost for the installation of signage and striping by Public Works staff is estimated to be \$3,500.	
Fiscal Impact: The estimated cost for installing the multi-way stop and associated cross improvements is approximately \$3,500. Funding would need to come from Public Works Street Paint and Signs budget

Recommended Action: Provide direction to staff on whether to proceed with the installation of the recommended multi-way stop and crosswalk improvements at Broadway and B Street.
