Resolution No. 11-14-23-SARDA

Resolution of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Needles, declaring the Successor Agency's completion of its responsibilities with respect to winding down the affairs of the former Redevelopment Agency of the City of Needles and requesting dissolution pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 34187 (b), and taking

related actions.

#### Background:

Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code (the "HSC") § 34172 (a) (1), the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Needles was dissolved on February 1, 2012. Consistent with the provisions of the HSC, the City Council of the City of Needles previously elected to serve in the capacity of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Needles (the "SARDA"). Pursuant to HSC § 34179, the SARDA previously established the Needles Oversight Board to assist in the wind-down of the former redevelopment agency through June 30, 2018, at which time it was dissolved by operation of law. Consistent with HSC § 34179 (j), on July 1, 2018 the San Bernardino Countywide Oversight Board (the "CWOB") was established to assist in winding-down the dissolved redevelopment agencies within the County of San Bernardino.

Per HSC § 34187 (b), when all of a successor agency's enforceable obligations have been retired or paid off, all real property has been disposed of pursuant to HSC § 34181 or 34191.4, and all outstanding litigation has been resolved, a successor agency shall, within 30 days of meeting the aforementioned criteria, submit to the oversight board applicable to a successor agency a request, with a copy of the request to the county auditor-controller, to formally dissolve a successor agency. The oversight board shall approve the request within 30 days, and shall submit the request to the California Department of Finance (the "DOF").

As of August 15, 2022, SARDA made its final payment on its 1992 Series A Tax Allocation Bonds, which retired and paid off its last third-party enforceable obligation. As of June 30, 2023, SARDA completed its final Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule, which completed its administrative enforceable obligations. Effective with the October 12, 2023 recordation of its quitclaim deed (i.e., Assessor's DOC # 2023-0252596) transferring the parcel identified as APN 0186-222-10-0000 (SARDA's last remaining Long Range Property Management Plan real property asset) to the Needles Public Utilities Authority for public purposes. Pursuant to the foregoing, SARDA no longer has any real property or monetary assets.

#### **Review and Approval Process:**

Consistent with HSC § 34187 (b), it is appropriate that SARDA be dissolved and request that the CWOB and DOF approve such dissolution. Approval of the attached resolution will confirm SARDA's request to dissolve and authorize the City Manager/Executive Director, or designee, to transmit SARDA's request for dissolution to the CWOB and, if approved by the CWOB, thereafter to the DOF.

Once approved by DOF, SARDA's dissolution shall be governed by the procedures described in HSC § 34187 (e), which requires that once DOF has approved a request to formally dissolve a successor agency, a successor agency shall take both of the following steps within 100 days of the DOF's notification: i) dispose of all remaining assets as directed by the oversight board and any proceeds from the disposition of assets shall be transferred to the county auditor-controller for distribution to the affected taxing entities pursuant to HSC § 34183; and ii) notify the oversight board that it has complied with the foregoing process.

The attached Resolution has been reviewed with respect to applicability of the California Environmental Quality Act (the "CEQA"), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, § 15000 et seq., hereafter the "CEQA Guidelines"), and the City's environmental guidelines. The attached Resolution does not constitute a "project" for purposes of CEQA, as that term is defined by CEQA Guidelines § 15378, because this Resolution is an administrative activity that will not result in a direct or indirect physical change in the environment, per § 15378 (b) (5) of the CEQA Guidelines.

- Section 3. Consistent with the foregoing, it is herewith requested that the CWOB and DOF approve SARDA's dissolution.
- Section 4. The City Manager/Executive Director, or designee, is authorized and directed to transmit SARDA's declaration of intent to dissolve and request for approval by the CWOB and the DOF.
- Section 5. Subject to approval by the CWOB and the DOF, the City Manager/Executive Director, or designee, is authorized to take all necessary steps to dissolve SARDA consistent with the provisions of HSC § 34187 (e).
- This Resolution has been reviewed with respect to applicability of the California Environmental Quality Act (the "CEQA"), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, § 15000 et seq., hereafter the "CEQA Guidelines"), and the City's environmental guidelines. This Resolution does not constitute a "project" for purposes of CEQA, as that term is defined by CEQA Guidelines § 15378, because this Resolution is an
