Title: 2024 Consumer Confidence Report

Background: A Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) is an annual report that community public water systems must provide to their customers about the quality of their drinking water The CCRs are required by the Safe Drinking Water Act. They summarize information about the water source, contaminants found, compliance with drinking water rules, and some educational materials.

CCRs typically include information on the water source, levels of contaminants found, compliance with drinking water rules, and educational materials about water quality and protection.

Community public water systems must deliver CCRs to their customers annually, typically by July 1st.

The EPA has also worked to make CCRs more accessible to consumers, such as by providing tools to help water systems create user-friendly reports.

In essence, a CCR is a valuable resource for consumers to stay informed about the quality of their drinking water and the efforts of their water system to ensure it is safe.
