Background:	As of October 1, 2019, the City has contracted with Transportation Concepts (contract operator of the deviated fixed route service NAT) to provide daily operation of the Dial-a-Ride (DAR) transportation service. The last DAR fare increase was July 1, 2018 but with the Covid pandemic hitting in 2020 and the effect on ridership, the San Bernardino County Transportation Authority (SBCTA) discouraged any fare increases in public transportation. With operating expenses continuing to rise and DAR ridership returning, this fare increase will help offset the farebox recovery and will bring the DAR fare in line with NAT's senior/disabled fare of \$1.25 per boarding. This increase has been discussed with SBCTA staff who agree that the increase is reasonable and prudent at this time.
