

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NEEDLES, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 FUNDED BY SB-1: THE ROAD
REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS Senate Bill 1 (SB-1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS SB-1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the City of Needles are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS the City of Needles must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB-1, which must include a description and the locations of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the projects' completion, and estimated useful life of the improvements; and

WHEREAS the City of Needles, will receive an estimated \$119,462 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2024-2025 from SB-1; and

WHEREAS the scope to include the following streets for Grind and Pave 1-1/2 to 2" with Petromat on the Streets identified in the **Phase 4B Street Improvement**; Desoto (*Parkway – Balboa St*), Carty Way, Carty Pl, Cary Cir, and El Monte (*Parkway to Coronado*) and **Phase 5 Street Improvements**; Parkway (*Lillyhill – Rio Vista*), J Street (*Parkway – Coronado*), Luna Vista (*Parkway – Balboa St*), Rio Vista (*Parkway – Coronado*), Calle Hernandez, Redwood, Santa Fe Cir, Larchwood, Casa Linda (*Lillyhill to Redwood*) La Cima Rd, San Clemente, Arizona Street, San Luis, Casa Del Sol, Casa Real, Clary Dr, Q St and North O Street and **Sidewalk Safety Repair Program** location is generally within the center of Needles proper.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Needles, California as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct

2. The following proposed and previously proposed and adopted projects may utilize fiscal year 2024-2025 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their life's delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution. The City of Needles is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.

- a. **Phase 4B Street Improvements;** Grind and Pave 1-1/2 to 2" with Petromat on Desoto (*Parkway – Balboa St*), Carty Way, Carty Pl, Cary Cir, and El Monte (*Parkway to Coronado*). Starting in 07/2024 and ending 06/2025 with a useful life of 20 years.
- b. **Phase 5 Street Improvements;** Grind and Pave 1-1/2 to 2" with Petromat on Parkway (*Lillyhill – Rio Vista*), J Street (*Parkway – Coronado*), Luna Vista (*Parkway – Balboa St*), Rio Vista (*Parkway – Coronado*), Calle Hernandez, Redwood, Santa Fe Cir, Larchwood, Casa Linda (*Lillyhill to Redwood*) La Cima Rd, San Clemente, Arizona Street, San Luis, Casa Del Sol, Casa Real, Clary Dr, Q St and North O Street Grind & Pave with Petromat. Starting in 07/2024 and ending 06/2025 with a useful life of 20 years.
- c. **Sidewalk Safety Repairs Program** will repair sidewalk sections that are broken / tripping hazards or lifted segments of sidewalk and replace with new. The location is generally within the center of Needles proper and covering approx. 3.5 sq miles. Starting in 07/2024 and ending 06/2025 with a useful life of 50 years.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Needles hereby adopt Resolution No 2024-21, SB-1 the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 plan to including street improvements under the Phase 4B & Phase 5 Improvement Plans of the Paving Management Plan and the repair of Public Sidewalks under the Sidewalk Safety Repair Program along with other funds.
