Title: Hydrotech Corporation for the		ge Order No. 1 to the Design-I atment Facility	Build Contract with Pacific
Background: On October 25, 2022, Pacific Hydrotech Corporation was awarded the Design-Build Contract for design and construction of the Well 11 Treatment Facility for a total contract amount of \$5,759,400.00.			
During construction, various issues/conflicts were identified that required changes to the work identified in the approved Basis of Design Report (BoDR) resulting in additional expenses to the project. These items are listed below:			
<ol> <li>Entrance Gate</li> <li>Chemical Tank</li> <li>Canopy &amp; Foundation</li> <li>Electrical Revisions</li> <li>Generator Relocation</li> </ol>	\$ 11, \$113, \$149,	,206.20 ,028.75 ,614.88 ,298.08 ,459.75	
Justification for approval of each item was received by the design engineer and presented to the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) and approved to be funded by the project contingency.			
Therefore, Change Order #1 includes items already approved by the SWRCB increasing the contract with PHC by \$338,607.66 for a new total contract amount of \$6,098,007.66.			
Fiscal Impact: The City received Grant Amendment #3 to the original Grant Agreement with the California State Water Resources Control Board in the amount of \$14,315,640.00 for water system improvements. The Well 11 Treatment Facility is identified as Phase 6A of the total project in the amount of \$5,759,500 with a \$717,104 allowable contingency.			
Change Order #1 for a total of \$338,607.66 is reimbursable from the contingency funds and results in a new total contract amount of \$6,098,007.66.			
<b>Recommended Action:</b> Accept Change Order #1 to the Design-Build Contract with Pacific Hydrotech Corporation for the Well 11 Treatment Facility project resulting in an increase to the contract in the amount of \$338,607.66 for a new total contract amount of \$6,098,007.66; and authorize staff to execute said Change Order.
