13	Commission's 2025 Budget Recommendation Updates
14	City Council did not approve the request to use funds for neighborhood grants - town
15	has tried something like this and it's not effective - They recommend we promote clean
16	up days
17	 The Parks department doesn't want the compostable bags because people may leave
18	the bag of poo on the ground and not pick it up.
19	Additional idea from New Castle town staff -
20	Composing program - Evergreen composting is now available to residents; could we
21	use the funds to jump start the program - first 50 people to sign up get 1st 6 months free;
22	\$132 per person - for first six months - \$1,320 for 10 people?
23	 Motion: Commissioner Leland moved that we budget as an Earth Day Drawing
24	for 10 people - 6 months of Evergreen Service. Commissioner Barnes seconded
25	Approved Unanimous - Refer back to city council
26	Expanding town clean up day to include Paint Recycling - town now does not accept
27	paint; CEC could contact Habitat for Humanity; paint collection day and recycle; - Check
28	their website & find out costs and contact person -
29	 Action Item: Commissioner Barnes volunteered to research and report back to
30	the council via Mindy.
31	 Add another town clean up day - requires staff overtime - \$15,000 - 17,000.
32	 Yard waste clean up - requires public works and parks - problem of not being
33	sustainable after the first year.
34	River clean up day - organize volunteers to clean up the river.
35	Wildfire collaborative - 22 organizations from Glenwood to Colbran are conducting a
36	study of high risk fire areas; pre and post wildfire mitigation - \$3,000 to fund the
37	collaborative. They have identified mitigation needs (and Elk Creek is one area).
38	 Motion: Commissioner Barnes moved to use the bag fee funds to fund the
39	\$3,000 to the collaborative and specifically for mitigation activities in the Elk
40	Creek high risk fire area. Commissioner Morris seconded. Votes passed
41	unanimously.
42	\$20,000 bag fee total
43	 \$750 for Containers for Chili cook-off (reimburse the town)

Fire Evaluation Plan

- 2 Town Administrator David Reynolds reported that information goes out in weekly e-news,
- 3 quarterly newsletter, and new development does not change the evacuation plan. It's not just a
- 4 wildfire evacuation plan but all types of evacuation. The plan takes into account a variety of
- 5 situations. They have secured grant funds and are prepared with signage when town
- 6 evaluations happen. Sign placement and evaluation will vary based on the specific emergency
- 7 situation. Depending on the situation, experts will direct residents as needed. Check out the
- 8 town evaluation document for more information. They review it every year. It's not specific
- 9 because the situation may change. Sign up for text messages from the town that will go out in
- 10 emergency situations...
