Commissioner Morris called the meeting to order at 4:04 p.m.

 Commissioner Morris announced that Michelle Huster, Assistant to the Clerk, will take over as CEC liaison from Town Clerk Mindy Andis.

Elemental Film Screening Debrief

• Commissioner Barnes reported on the successful film showing of "Elemental: Reimagine Wildfire." Forty people attended the event. Three expert panelists, Zach Pigati, Paul Smith, and Kate Collins, led the Q&A after the film.

Honoring Chair Tom Elder

Town Manager Dave Reynolds relayed that Ryan Barkman from the Parks & Rec
department reported that Rollie Gordon Park isn't viable as a dig site for Tom's memorial
tree due to too many underground and overground obstructions. Tom's life celebration is
on April 17th from 2-4 pm at the Lakota clubhouse, and we would like to coordinate the
tree planting ceremony for that morning with a plaque presentation. A non-fruiting
flowering crabapple tree will be planted.

Action item:

 Chair Morris will contact Tom's widow to get her preference for tree planting on the site.

Earth Day Update

- Commissioner Leland reported there are twelve confirmed participants for Earth Day. Commissioner Bakich stated that the Girls STEM Leadership Club at Elk Creek Elementary would participate in the event.
- The event will run from 11am-2pm. Commissioners should arrive at 9am for set-up.
- Promotion ideas include announcing on the town's digital sign, posting flyers, sending
 a press release to Post Independent, announcing in the town's newsletter, and posting
 on Next Door and Facebook.

Action item

- Chair Morris will contact the BLM and Parks and Wildlife and invite them to participate.
- Commissioner Leland will create the flyer.
- Commissioner Koch will investigate the t-shirt design.

Review Approved Budget and 2025 Projects

 Commissioner Leland noted a few changes to the approved bag fee budget, including an increased cost of reusable bowls and cutlery and a future projects line item. • Chair Morris recommended that we postpone working on additional projects until Earth Day is complete. The commission will calendar out the rest of their projects for the year.

CEC Website

 will check on the cost of additional web pages.
- The commission agreed to remove the fire videos from the website.
- The commission agreed to add a section to the website for fire prevention, pollinators, xeriscaping, composting, living with wildlife, renewable energy, evacuation plan, consumption reduction, volunteer recruitment, and bag fee expenditures.

• Chair Morris asked for feedback on the commission's meeting time. The group agreed to keep at 4pm on the 3rd Thursday of the month.

Town Council Update
