WHEREAS, the team ended the season with a 27-3-1 record; and

WHEREAS, Coach Larson called 2025 "clearly the greatest season in the history of Coal Ridge Baseball."

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of New Castle concurs with Coach Larson and congratulates the state's newest 3A baseball champions; and
