**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW CASTLE TOWN COUNCIL APPROVING A(N)
AGREEMENT(S) WITH THE COLORADO BRIDGE AND TUNNEL ENTERPRISE.**

WHEREAS, The Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”), the Colorado Bridge and Tunnel Enterprise (“CBTE”) and the Town of New Castle (“Town”) desire to work together to maintain bike and pedestrian mobility across Elk Creek adjacent to US 6 with a detached pedestrian bridge to, among other things, replace the current pedestrian bridge attached to US 6; and

WHEREAS, the CBTE will provide design and construction funding for the detached pedestrian bridge; and

WHEREAS, the CDOT will allow the pedestrian bridge to be located within CDOT’s right of way; and

WHEREAS, upon completion the Town will take full and complete ownership and maintenance, repair, and replacement responsibilities associated with the detached pedestrian bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that entering into an agreement or agreements effectuating the transfer of ownership and maintenance, repair, and replacement responsibilities of the completed pedestrian bridge to The Town will further the Town’s goals and is in the Town’s best interests.

WHEREAS, upon the passing of this resolution the Town, CDOT and CBTE will commence drafting the appropriate agreements that are anticipated to be formally executed in the summer/fall 2026 when the pedestrian bridge is currently expected to be complete; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NEW CASTLE TOWN COUNCIL:

1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated by reference as findings and determinations of the Town Council.
2. Adoption. Pursuant to Section 14.4 of the Town Charter, the Town Council hereby approves this resolution and authorizes the Mayor to execute the same.
