

**CITY OF NEW MEADOWS CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
HELD MONDAY, MAY 11TH , 2026 AT 6:30 PM

Roll Call/Pledge of Allegiance

Present at City Hall were Mayor Julie Good, Council Members Jeff Parnett, Jessica Lillehaug, Traci Foster. Council Member Shiloh Ryker was excused.

City Attorney Chris Yorgason, Sandy Shiffman, AIC Executive Director Kelly Packer, and Kim & Joe Dalrymple were present via Zoom.

Mayor Good opened the meeting at 6:36 P.M. followed by roll call & The Pledge of Allegiance.

Candidate Introductions

Adams County candidates running for County Commissioner Darren Ward and Kyle Johnson Presented & gave introductions to the City Council.

2026 Legislation Session Update

Executive Director of AIC Kelly Packer gave an update on the 2026 legislative session.

Reports

Mayors Report

Mayor Good presented her Mayor's report to the council.

Staff Reports

City Council member Foster asked about the stop signs at the 3 way stop on South Heigho, asking if they were the correct size and placement as she had heard they were not? Sheriff Zollman confirmed they were not the right size & Mayor Good explained that this is a learning experience and that the signs would be replaced eventually when we got our Sign Grant money in the next few months.

Discussion Items

Law Enforcement Agreement- Sheriff Zollman

Sheriff Zollman explained that the costs are rising, making it tougher for everyone. Sheriff Zollman asked for an increase in the City's contract from \$33,660 to \$40,000.

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Zollman explained that they had made 441 Traffic stops with in the last year, 42 written Citations, 30 written warnings and the others elevated into some sort of an arrest. Zollman explained that he feels that he has held up on their side of the bargain by giving very enhanced enforcement.

Public Comment on Allowing Dogs in Dorsey Warr Park

Brittney Hill emailed in that she thinks the poop bags are a great idea. Mayor Good asked the audience what their opinions were. Four people agreed to put poop bags in the park. This item will be placed on the next agenda as an action item, At that time, the City will need to update the ordinance.

Ordinance Title 9 Chapter 4 – Building Numbers

Mayor Good suggested that Ordinance Title 9 Chapter 4 be updated to include reflective house numbers.

- Council Member Foster made a motion to approve the Short Term RV use Permit for Goeckner for six months only, to be renewed a limit of two times. Council Member Parnett seconded the motion. Voice Vote indicated one opposition to the motion with all members signifying yes except for City council member Lillehaug. Motion carried.

Industrial Park Rental Application Approval

- Council Member Parnett moved to Approve a one year Industrial park lease with Dalrymple construction LLC. Council Member Foster seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Foster– yes, Lillehaug– No, Parnett – yes. Motion Carried.

Declaration of City Surplus items: Tires, Netting, & Clutch

- Council Member Foster moved to declare the following items as City Surplus: Tires, Netting, & Clutch. Council Member Parnett seconded the motion. Voice Vote indicated no opposition to the motion with all members signifying yes. Motion carried.
