

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEW MEADOWS AND THE
MEADOWS VALLEY AMBULANCE DISTRICT

The City of New Meadows, by and through the New Meadows City Council, and the Meadows Valley Ambulance District, by and through the Adams County Board of County Commissioners, in order to allow the City to include any Ambulance District development requirements or fees in the City's dealings with real estate developers, and to provide the Ambulance District with notice of any changes to the City's ordinances and zoning laws that could affect the Ambulance District, and in consideration of the mutual benefit to each, do hereby Agree to the following:

That the City of New Meadows and the Meadows Valley Ambulance District agree to provide one another notice of potential impact fees, requirements, ordinances and laws that could impact the Ambulance District and/or the City and to remain engaged in communication regarding possible development impacts on the Ambulance District and its operations.

This Memorandum will remain in effect unless affirmatively terminated by decision of the City Council or Board of County Commissioners (with written notice to the other party of the same), or until the dissolution of the City or the Ambulance District.

The undersigned represent that they have been duly authorized to execute this Memorandum of Understanding.
