This month has been busy. We have patched the asphalt on Norris st with 25 bags of cold patch. I serviced the dump truck (all filters and fluid changed). I greased all of the fittings on the dump truck. I fixed the street sweeper which had a bad bearing that caused the roller to fall out. I swept the town with the skid steer. I raked and packed 220.5' of the sidewalk project. I cleaned and restocked the bathrooms 2-3 times per week and emptied the 5 trash cans at the park 2 times per week. I have cut the grass at the park each Monday and moved the irrigation system each morning. We are going to be needing some new lines to prevent flooding in the park. I fixed 13 meter antennas, and I repaired one meter pit. I conducted another city clean up with only my wife to help. We hauled off 8 dump truck loads. I would love to see some of the city council members out and about on these days to engage with the people of the town. It's a great opportunity to get to talk with the people you make decisions for.

I removed the logs from the park and assisted Jess with installing a new border. I also added several backhoe loads of gravel to the park to help with the flooding from the sprinkler system. As per the last city council meeting, I cleaned off the old skate park asphalt and attempted to level out the old bicycle track. As soon as I get a green light from city council, I can proceed to make a bike track with the backhoe. I have several people interested in helping design and build the skate park and will be asking them to come to a meeting soon.

I replaced the fuel pump at the booster station to facilitate the fire pump fuel tank. I put new signs at the park for no animals and no overnight parking. I also placed several other signs in regards to the parking on the right of way. I replaced several stop signs this month as well. I flushed all of the fire hydrants in the entire town this month which facilitates keeping the drinking water lines clean. I have a list of hydrants that need attention. This is my summary of the last few weeks. I still enjoy this job very much and I love our community.
