Staff Report – June 14, 2021

In the last month we have serviced and greased the heavy equipment and the lawnmower. The oil was changed in the mower, new blades were installed, and a tire was repaired on the mower. We have replaced several water meters and had them updated in the system. We have watered many of the roads and conducted road blading. We are preparing for dust abatement on 17 June. The sidewalk project was started, and I compacted the dirt. A concrete shortage has us in standby. We conducted sewer line camera operations with Integrity Solutions. We cleaned the sewer lines on several streets. We have assisted the school with several projects. I conducted training in Boise at the Idaho Rural Water Association conference.

We have been in the process of leak testing our lagoons and have been having some setbacks due to weather or equipment issues. I conducted our first community clean up with my wife Lisa, my son Tony and Angie Mettie. I have been trying to find someone who can paint our park bathrooms with an artistic touch. I have not received any submissions yet. I have been doing my best to keep up with the amount of trash and glass bottles being thrown on the ground in the park. I've been trying to change the trash bags every few days.

In the next community cleanup, we may only have the dump truck and no backhoe. I will conduct one pass per road starting at 930 on the 19th of June. On 7 June at approximately 2pm we had yet another illegal sewer dumping incident. I caught the incident before it could get out of hand. We had several hundred gallons of water coming from between McLain and Taylor streets. I have replaced several signs throughout the city. We will be ordering more signs this week. As the signs come in, we will install them.
