

*I move to introduce Ordinance TBD-2021, amending Title 5, Chapter 3 of the New Meadows City Code, and suspend the rules requiring three separate readings on three separate days and read by title only once; seconded. ROLL CALL VOTE*

City Clerk reads the ordinance by title only.

Kyla reads:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW MEADOWS, ADAMS COUNTY, IDAHO, AMENDING TITLE 5, CHAPTER 3 SECTION 3, OF THE NEW MEADOWS CITY CODE AS FOLLOWS: IN SECTION 5-3-3, REMOVE “DOGS” FROM TITLE AND REPLACE WITH “ANIMALS;” ADD THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO KEEP, MAINTAIN OR POSSESS UPON THE PREMISES OF ANY ONE HOUSEHOLD MORE THAN (3) CATS. PROVIDED, THAT IN THE EVENT THE NUMBER OF CATS UPON THE PREMISES OF ANY ONE HOUSEHOLD EXCEEDS THE NUMBER OF THREE (3) FOR THE REASON THAT NEWBORN OFFSPRING HAVE BEEN BORN TO A CAT LIVING ON SAID PREMISES, THEN AND IN THAT EVENT, IT SHALL BE LAWFUL TO KEEP, MAINTAIN AND POSSESS UPON SAID PREMISES SAID OFFSPRING UNTIL THEY REACH THE AGE OF THREE (3) MONTHS.
