

## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEW MEADOWS AND ADAM COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY, INC.

WHEREAS Adams County Historical Society, Inc. owns the parking area in front of the Historic Pacific & Idaho Northern Railway Depot at 101 Commercial Avenue. in New Meadows, Idaho.

WHEREAS the City of New Meadows has a need for public parking in the summer for those attending the farmer's market and other events in the City of New Meadows or at the Dorsey Warr Memorial Park.

WHEREAS Adams County Historical Society, Inc. is willing to allow the City of New Meadows to use the parking area in front of the Historical Pacific & Idaho Northern Railway Depot for public parking in the summer for those attending the farmer's market and other events in the City of New Meadows or at the Dorsey Warr Memorial Park.

WHEREAS the City of New Meadows agrees to make two passes through the parking area in front of the Historic Pacific & Idaho Northern Railway Depot during the winter when there is six inches of snow or more on the ground.

WHEREAS the City of New Meadows agrees to grade the parking area in front of the Historic Pacific & Idaho Northern Railway Depot once a year.

WHEREAS if an event is held at the Historic Pacific & Northern Idaho Railway Depot requiring parking for a particular day or weekend, the City of New Meadows will post signs near the Depot that parking is closed in the area during that time.

For the consideration identified above, Adams County Historical Society, Inc. and the City of New Meadows agree that the City of New Meadows may the parking area in front of the Historical Pacific & Northern Idaho Railway Depot for public parking in the summer for those attending the farmer's market and other events in the City of New Meadows or at the Dorsey Warr Memorial Park until thirty (30) days after Adams County Historical Society, Inc. notifies the City of New Meadows that it is no longer allowed to use the parking area. If and when Adams County Historical Society, Inc. no longer allows the City of New Meadows to use the parking area, the City of New Meadows will no longer be required to make two passes through the parking area during the winter, to grade the parking area or post signs near the Depot that parking is closed in the area during certain times.
