The Alaska Historical Commission (AHC) met on May 25, 2021 to review grant applications and recommend awards for Historic Preservation Fund (HPF) projects for Certified Local Governments. The application submitted by your entity titled "King Island-East End Park Entrance Sign & Interpretative Panel Project" was recommended for a 60-40 matching grant.

This HPF grant award of \$5,130 is contingent upon the Office of History and Archaeology (OHA) receipt of FFY-21 federal funds. Upon notification of the federal appropriation for this HPF program, OHA will issue a grant agreement for your review and execution.
