## 2024 Statistics

Dates of comparison are from start of year 1-1-24 till 3-27-24, compared with the same timeline to 2023.

*REQUEST: (A) Review periodic reports prepared by the public safety department to detect trends evident in Nome as portrayed through police statistics, separated by race and sex, including general information regarding the number of sexual assault and domestic violence calls, status of sexual assault and domestic violence cases including status of victim follow-up, the number of public inebriation calls, the number of alcohol and drug abuse calls and the number of felony investigations.*

Data was obtained from Crimestar RMS.

## Calls for Service (These are calls generated by the Nome Police Dispatch Center)

We are showing a slight increase of 375 in calls for services. We have 18% current alcohol involvement, stagnate from last year. Please refer later to incident (reports) that are created from an Officer that involve alcohol, the percentage is much higher.

## Sexual Assault

Sexual Assault statistics are determined by two different call types in our record management system "Sexual Assault" and "Sexual Abuse."

OVERALL

Sexual assaults for the year compared to last year has slightly increased.

At the current rate of cases if it stays consistent we will reach approximately 30-50 for the year.

Investigator Nguyen has been at the helm of Investigations as our new Investigator, he just passed his 6 months in his new position.

Community Liaison (DV/SA Coordinator) – Sharon Sparks has been doing an excellent job with follow up and resource materials as well as keeping the community updated.

There will be an added Advocate position to help Sharon’s work load to focus on Domestic Violence.

Currently we have a decrease in charges. The Alaska Court system has been actively resuming trials to catch up from COVID times.

### Incidents (Reports) – this is after a Call for Service is generated that would require more written narrative such as arrests, investigations, charges, death investigations, etc.

Overall, 66% of all reports created by patrol staff are alcohol involved this is a realistic picture of how often alcohol is involved in an officer’s shift. Out of every (6 or so) official reports, one of them is roughly domestic violence related.

“Intoxicated Person” Is the criteria used to obtain our intoxicated person down statistics. I wanted to portray since 2020, here is the numbers at a glance – from Jan 1 to 3-27 for the respective years.
