On November 4, 2019, Norton Sound Economic Development Corporation (NSEDC) sent a Community Benefit Share (CBS) distribution letter to the City of Nome (City) that addressed NSEDC's audit process for the CBS funds.

Per the CBS program policies, NSEDC requires an audit of the expenditure of the 2019 and previously issued CBS funds. This requires the municipality to provide relevant financials, copies of invoices and checks, or other information which documents the procurement of items or services as outlined in your prior years' declarations. By accepting the CBS, your community acknowledges and agrees to comply with the audit requirement of the funding. Disbursement of future CBS funding cannot occur until audits are complete for prior years' distributions.
