GovOS processes for jurisdictions 4.20.21.pdf;

Hi Nickie,

GovOS is the filing platform we use for sales tax collection. Sellers upload a single excel file with gross and exempted sales for each jurisdiction and then the program calculates the sales tax, timely filing discount, late fee, penalty, and interest as applicable. A seller pays a single payment per filing. We run reports to see how the sales tax is distributed based on the reporting.

The emails ncrowe@nomealaska.org, bhammond@nomealaska.org and bsoske@nomealaska.org can access the system. I have attached an overview of the different reports a jurisdiction user can run, but honestly, it is easier for you to ask us questions about filings than try to find the info yourselves.

TTR (now called ATR) is the tax map. We work with them to create the tax matrix which is based on the jurisdiction's municipal sales tax code. The matrix is approved upon joining the Commission. A user can type in any address to see the sales tax rate for that location. The tax map also displays a general overview of the tax rules and specific information regarding exemption categories.

For buyers outside a tax district, they can enter their address and export a document that shows \$0 tax at their location and they can give that to companies to prove their tax rate.

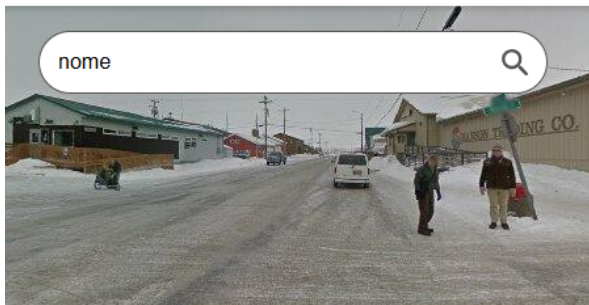

The Commission is the Alaska Remote Seller Sales Tax Commission (ARSSTC). The Commission charges an overhead that covers the financial obligations to run the program. This covers the contact with the Alaska Municipal League (AML) which ARSSTC hired to implement the sales tax collection. This fee also covers any additional costs such as filing platform upgrades. The budget for ARSSTC (which is based on this monthly fee) is set by the Board of Directors and will be discussed further at our next board meeting.
