POSTPONEMENT OF THE ANNUAL REPORT FROM WESTWOOD
GOLF AND GOLF MAINTENANCE

DISCUSSION:

The Westwood Golf Course was designed in 1967 by golf architect Floyd Farley and later redesigned in 2003 by Tripp Davis. The 6,200-yard course was recently renovated and features wide, tree-lined fairways, gently contoured greens, 20 traps, and several water hazards. The challenging, yet playable course, is perfect for the weekend golfer or the advanced competitor. Open year-round, Westwood is well-known throughout the metropolitan area as an excellent municipal golf course that consistently offers exceptional greens. Along with the course itself, the facility features an on-site driving range (featuring "Lunch and Launch" on weekdays), practice putting and chipping greens, a clubhouse, a golf shop, a restaurant, and an outdoor scoreboard with an adjoining patio. Rates are affordable, and tee times and professional lessons are both available daily. Every year, the course hosts The Westwood Invitational, a 3-day, 54-hole stroke-play tournament that usually takes place around July 4th. It is one of the state's largest and longest-running tournaments.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends submitting the Westwood Golf annual report to the City Council once the Board of Park Commissioners accepts the annual report.
