

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN,
OKLAHOMA, AMENDING THE AIM NORMAN COMPREHENSIVE
LAND USE PLAN TO REMOVE THE 30-ACRE URBAN RESERVE
LAND USE MINIMUM REQUIREMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Norman recognizes citizens' concerns about the future development of Norman; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the City Council at its meeting of June 24, 2025, reviewed and adopted the AIM Norman Comprehensive Land Use Plan, with an effective date of June 24, 2025; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, City of Norman has requested an amendment to the AIM Norman Comprehensive Land Use Plan to remove the 30-acre Urban Reserve Land Use minimum requirement for development; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 5. That the Council of the City of Norman recognizes the need to control the future growth of the City of Norman; and, that after due consideration has determined that the requested amendment to the AIM Norman Comprehensive Land Use Plan should be adopted, and does hereby approve the identified amendments.
