UPDATE FROM DR. GABRIEL BIRD REGARDING THE NORMAN FLAG PROJECT.

Dr. Bird said that the Flag Project is in full swing. The cut off for submissions is March 19, 2020 and they hope to have the public voting the first week of April. The voting information will be emailed out and will also be posted at normanflag.com. The timeline in place will allow for the winner to be selected and prototypes made for the June 9th, 2020, City Council agenda. At that time the Flag Committee will make the recommendation to Council to adopt the new flag effective June 14, 2020, which is Flag Day. The names and any identifying factors of the submissions will be removed before they go before the Committee. So this will make it a true blind selection and Dr. Bird will be recusing himself. Dr. Bird said this project is privately funded and it will also be paying for all of the current City flags to be replaced around town. So there will be no cost to the City at all. The current City flag will still remain as the City seal. There will be no copyright on the new flag and there is a full disclosure on the project website for all applicants to read and agree to.

Councilmember Wilson would like someone to look into protecting the design of the flag since it will not be copyrighted. She knows that we will have a Resolution that should help protect it but would like to be sure.
