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Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

- Previously called "Basic"
- 1 semester at a vo-tech or college
- Basic anatomy & physiology
- Patient assessment, trauma, BLS, splinting, triage, limited medication usage





Advanced

- Previously called "Intermediate"
- 2 semesters at a vo-tech or college
- Advanced trauma training, IV skills, airway management including intubation, some more medications
- Considered on the same level as an LPN





<u>Paramedic</u>

- 2 years at a vo-tech or college
- Cardiology training including 12-lead & ACLS, pediatric training to include PALS, advanced medication administration, toxicology, obstetrics, psych, geriatrics
- Considered on the same level as an RN





Critical Care Paramedic

- On-the-job training and continuing education
- Can take 6 months to 2 years
- Training on advanced hemodynamics, advanced pharmacology, ventilators, aortic balloon pumps,
 IV blood administration








Call Volume

EMSSTAT Total Volume by Town


















August 2025 911 Destination Summary












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August 2025 Out of Chute Times









911 Transport Times





August 2025 Average Offload Time by Destination Ambulance Patient Offload Time by Destination (APOT)












August 2025 Average Offload Time NRHS Only












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August 2025 Offload Time Distribution NRHS Only










