

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, ADOPTING AN ANTI-DISPLACEMENT PLAN FOR EXECUTION OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM AND THE HOME (HOME) INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City of Norman is an Entitlement Community for both the CDBG and HOME programs as funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the City of Norman utilizing the funding provided by these programs may cause temporary or permanent displacement of residents in conjunction with the activities associated; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the City of Norman recognizes that any permanent displacement associated with the use of CDBG or HOME funding will require implementation of the regulations within the Uniform Relocation Act;
- § 4. WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development requires formal adoption of an Anti-Displacement Plan for CDBG and HOME Programs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 5. That the Anti-Displacement Plan set forth in Exhibit One be adopted and implemented for both the CDBG Program and the HOME Program.
