ITEM TITLE: CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION, REJECTION, AMENDMENT, AND/OR POSTPONEMENT OF RESOLUTION R-2122-47: A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, ADOPTING THE ANTI-DISPLACEMENT PLAN FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AND HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMS.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Norman was first awarded funding from the US Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) in 1977. At that time Policies and Procedures that were developed including an Anti-Displacement Plan. This plan, although never formally adopted, has been followed since the inception of the CDBG and HOME programs. With the recent acceptance of the CDBG CV3 award from the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, a formal acceptance of the Anti-Displacement Plan is required and is attached as Exhibit One.

DISCUSSION:

The Anti-Displacement Plan is detailed in Exhibit One and describes the policies that the City of Norman will undertake in the execution of the CDBG and HOME programs to avoid displacement and relocation. Given that both the CDBG and HOME Programs are federally funded, the Uniform Relocation Act is required to be enforced if the situation occurs where permanent displacement occurs as a result of projects funded by these two programs.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends acceptance of Resolution R-2122-47.
