

A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF MAY 17TH THROUGH 23RD, 2026 AS PUBLIC WORKS WEEK IN THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, public works professionals focus on infrastructure, facilities and services that are of vital importance to sustainable and resilient communities and to the public health, high quality of life and well-being of the people of Norman, Oklahoma; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, these infrastructure, facilities and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works, professionals, who are engineers, managers, and employees at all levels of government; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the citizens, civic leaders, and children in the City of Norman to gain knowledge of and to maintain an ongoing interest and understanding of the importance of public works and public works programs in their respective communities; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the City of Norman Public Works Department will celebrate by educating local school children in the aspects of public works operations on May 18th, volunteering time to improve an educational public space on May 19th, recognizing employees for their outstanding support of the goals of public works on May 20th, and engaging the community with a Public Works art contest that begins May 4th through May 19th; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, the year 2026 marks the 66th annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 6. Do hereby designate the week of May 17 – 23, 2026 as National Public Works Week; I urge all citizens to join with representatives of the American Public Works Association and government agencies in activities, events, and ceremonies designed to pay tribute to our public works professionals, engineers, managers, and employees and to recognize the substantial contributions they make to protecting our national health, safety, and quality of life.
