ITEM TITLE: CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION, REJECTION, AMENDMENT, AND/OR POSTPONEMENT OF RESOLUTION R-2526-142: A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AND THE NORMAN MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY TRANSFERRING \$41,000 FROM THE STREET MAINTENANCE BOND (GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND SERIES 2023B) FUND BALANCE TO ROBINSON STREET PROJECTS LOCATED BETWEEN 60TH AVENUE NE AND 72ND AVENUE N.E. AND 72ND AVENUE N.E. AND 84TH AVENUE N.E. AS OUTLINED IN THE STAFF REPORT. (WARD 5)

BACKGROUND:

On Tuesday, April 6, 2021, Norman residents voted to approve the 2021-2026 Street Maintenance Bond Program which includes the issuance of \$27 million in bonds to fund the resurfacing, rehabilitation and reconstruction of neighborhood streets. The five categories of street maintenance include (1) Urban Asphalt Pavement Street Rehabilitation, (2) Urban Concrete Street Rehabilitation, (3) Urban Road Reconstruction, (4) Rural Road Rehabilitation, and (5) Preventive Maintenance. This program is on schedule and all original projects included in program are slated for completion by June 2026.

DISCUSSION:

This item will transfer funds from the Street Maintenance Bond (General Obligation Bond Series 2023B) Fund Balance (Account No. 50-29000) to the two (2) projects listed below to account for increased costs associated with the projects.

The project locations and transfer amounts are identified as follows:

RECOMMENDATION NO. 1:

Staff recommends transfer of funds in the amount of \$41,000.00 from the Street Maintenance Bond (General Obligation Bond Series 2023B) Fund Balance (Account No. 50-29000) to Robinson Street projects located between 60th Avenue NE and 72nd Avenue NE and 72nd Avenue NE and 84th Avenue NE as outlined in the staff report.
