1. Proposal Summary

Preferred Service CNG proposes to monitor the CNG station and reset faults as needed. During after hours, holidays, and weekends. We also propose to perform on-site emergency repair work and non-emergency scheduled repairs and maintenance as needed.



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2. Scope of Services

Preferred Service CNG will set up a system to call us when there is a CNG station fault. When we get a call then a technician will get to site within 2 hours, reset the fault and repair as needed.

4. Detailed Cost Proposal

A. Monthly cost for monitoring equipment, monitoring service & remote reset of alarms. \$2000 a month Added phone line if needed \$70 a month.

B. Alternate #2: Monthly cost for monitoring equipment, monitoring service & remote reset of alarms, and on-site alarm reset. \$2000 a month Added phone line if needed \$70 a month.

C. Alternate #3: Monthly cost for monitoring equipment, monitoring service & remote reset of alarms, on-site alarm reset, and on site emergency repair work Hourly rate with an hourly minimum. \$2000 a month. Hourly rate \$161.25 with a minimum of \$322.50. Added phone line if needed \$70 a month.

D. Alternate # 4: Monthly cost for monitoring equipment, monitoring service & remote reset of alarms, on-site alarm reset, and on site emergency repair work Hourly rate with an hourly minimum, and an hourly rate for non-emergency schedule repairs/maintenance work with an hourly minimum. \$2000 a month. Emergency Hourly rate \$161.25 with a minimum of \$322.5. Non Emergency Hourly rate \$107.50 with a minimum of \$215. Added phone line if needed \$70 a month.



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5. Project Completion Schedule

Preferred Service CNG will install a Viking multi-input voice dialer/announcer and get a new phone line setup if needed to tie into. After notice to proceed is given we should be able to complete installation within a week with the cooperation of the phone company.
