

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN,
OKLAHOMA, AWARDED THE 2023 CITY OF NORMAN
HUMAN RIGHTS AWARD, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE
NORMAN HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City of Norman entrusts the Norman Human Rights Commission with the duties of studying problems of discrimination, advising City Council on human rights issues, and coordinating citizen involvement in the promotion of human rights; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Norman Human Rights Commission seeks to promote and encourage fair treatment and mutual understanding among all citizens and to combat all prejudice, bigotry, and discrimination that prevent individuals from reaching their full potential as human beings; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, after receiving nominations from the Norman community, the Norman Human Rights Commission selects an individual to receive the Norman Human Rights Award based on exceptional achievement, outstanding effort, and/or leadership to promote human rights and equality and to serve as an example to all.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 4. THAT the City of Norman, Oklahoma, in conjunction with the Norman Human Rights Commission, does hereby award the 2023 City of Norman Human Rights Award to Cleveland County District Judge Michael D. Tupper.
