

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, REQUESTING \$18,797.31 APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM RISK MANAGEMENT MISCELLANEOUS REIMBURSEMENTS/REFUNDS ACCOUNT TO REPAIR AND REPLACE TRAFFIC SIGNAL EQUIPMENT OR TRAFFIC SIGNS DAMAGED IN TRAFFIC COLLISIONS.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Control Division maintains more than 170 traffic and pedestrian signals and approximately 30,000 traffic control signs throughout the City, using operating funds to purchase replacement components necessary for the safe and efficient operation of the City's traffic control infrastructure; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, traffic collisions have resulted in damage to traffic signals, pedestrian poles, school beacon assemblies, streetlight poles, and traffic signs, requiring the City to use its resources and spare equipment inventory to make necessary repairs and restore safe roadway operations; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the City has collected \$18,797.31 in reimbursements for damages to traffic signal and streetlight equipment and \$246.71 for damages to traffic sign equipment, which have been deposited into the Refunds/Reimbursements Risk Management account; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, continued traffic collisions and resulting damage deplete the City's inventory of spare traffic control equipment, and the Traffic Control Division does not have sufficient operating funds to replenish these replacement units; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, these funds should be appropriated to repair and replace traffic signal equipment damaged in traffic collisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 6. THAT the following receipt and appropriation be made for reasons as stated above:
