A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION TO SEEK MEMBERSHIP IN THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF RETIRED PERSONS NETWORK OF AGE-FRIENDLY COMMUNITIES.

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization and AARP have developed frameworks to guide communities in becoming Age-Friendly, which include key domains such as housing, transportation, outdoor spaces, social participation, respect and inclusion, civic engagement, communication, and community support services; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the City of Norman is committed to supporting the well-being of residents of all ages and recognizes the valuable contributions of older adults to the community; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, adopting Age-Friendly policies and practices benefits residents of all ages and strengthens the city's infrastructure, accessibility, and social cohesion; and
- § 7. WHEREAS, The City of Norman will engage with residents, community partners, and relevant organizations to assess local needs to identify priorities for age-friendly improvements, and will seek designation through the AARP Network of Age-Friendly States and Communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

§ 8. The City of Norman hereby declares its commitment to becoming a part of the AARP Network of Certified Age-Friendly Communities by collaborating across departments to implement age-friendly strategies and pursue funding or partnerships where appropriate.
