ITEM TITLE: CONSIDERATION OF AWARDING, ACCEPTANCE, REJECTION, AMENDMENT, AND/OR POSTPONEMENT OF BID 2526-45: SUBMITTED BY US LIME COMPANY- ST CLAIR, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$367.71 PER TON FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIME FOR THE WATER TREATMENT FACILITY.

BACKGROUND:

Bids were advertised in the paper and on May 21, 2026, bids were opened for Bid 2526-45 for Lime. Lime is used to adjust pH for lime softening in the treatment of water. Funds in the amount of \$1,435,146 have been budgeted in the fiscal year 2026-2027 (FYE 2027) Budget, Water Fund - Water Treatment Plant - Operating Chemicals (account 31955234 43108) for purchase of all treatment chemicals.

DISCUSSION:

Specifications for Bid 2526-45 for Lime were sent to nine (9) vendors, and one (1) bid and two (2) no bids were received. No-bids were due to uncertain costs and supply demands. US Lime Company- St Clair of Marble City, OK, submitted the lowest and best bid meeting all specifications for \$367.71 per ton. This compares to a cost of \$304.49 per ton for an increase of 20.76 percent. This increase has occurred due to shipping/transporting costs.

RECOMMENDATION:

Purchases will be made throughout FYE 2027. Bids have been examined by staff and found to be in order and proper as to form. Based upon the above information, staff recommends acceptance of Lime bid from US Lime Company, St. Clair at a price \$367.71 per ton.
