A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AUTHORIZING AND APPOINTING NASH CONSTRUCTION COMPANY AS PROJECT AGENT FOR THE VINEYARD DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the City of Norman, Oklahoma, does hereby acknowledge that the tax-exempt status of this political subdivision is a significant factor in determining the agreed contract price bid by Nash Construction Company for the Vineyard Drainage Improvement Project for the City of Norman; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the City of Norman, Oklahoma, in compliance with State law, desires to confer on Nash Construction Company its special State and Federal sales tax exemptions and in order to achieve such end, finds it necessary to appoint as its direct purchasing agent, Nash Construction Company, to purchase materials which are in fact used for the Vineyard Drainage Improvement Project for the City of Norman; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, this limited agent status is conferred with the express understanding that Nash Construction Company shall appoint employees and subcontractors as subagents who shall be authorized to make purchases on their behalf.
