MINUTES

The Floodplain Permit Committee of the City of Norman, Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma, met in Regular Session in Conference Room B at the Development Center, on the 20th day of July 2026, at 3:30 p.m., and notice of the agenda of the meeting was posted at the Norman Municipal Building at 201 West Gray, the Development Center at 225 N. Webster Avenue, and on the City website at least 24 hours prior to the beginning of the meeting.

ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Miles at 3:30 p.m. Roll was taken and a quorum of five members was established. Committee members in attendance included Bill Scanlon, Resident Member; Sherri Stansel, Resident Member; Tim Miles, City Engineer; Ken Danner, Subdivision Development Manager; and Lora Hoggatt, Planning Services Manager. Other staff in attendance included Jason Murphy, Stormwater Program Manager; Michelle Scott, Administrative Technician.

MINUTES

Approval of minutes of June 15th, 2026, meeting

A correction was requested to the spelling of Dee Greninger's name in the roll call.

Mr. Scanlon motioned to approve with correction. Mr. Danner seconded the motion. The minutes were approved by a 5-0 vote.

ACTION ITEMS

1. Floodplain Permit No. 745

Mr. Miles stated that the floodplain permit application is for removal of a dilapidated pavilion and concrete pad at Andrews Park, north of 201 West Dawes Street. The applicant is the City of Norman Parks and Recreation Department, and the engineer is Brandon Brooks.

Mr. Murphy explained that the pavilion, which was in the Imhoff Creek floodway, had already been removed. If the permit is approved, the remaining concrete pad will be removed, the site will be graded generally toward the creek, and sod will be installed to stabilize the area. No replacement structure is currently proposed.

Mr. Murphy stated that compensatory storage is not required for the project and that staff recommends approval of Floodplain Permit Application No. 745.

Committee Action:

Mr. Danner motioned to approve. Mr. Scanlon seconded to approve the permit. Floodplain Permit No. 745 was approved with a vote of 5-0.

MISCELLANEOUS DISCUSSION

Mr. Murphy stated that no applications were pending for the next meeting. Mr. Danner asked about the status of a floodplain permit for a manufactured home on Rock Creek Road. Staff advised that no application had been submitted and that they would follow up.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Danner motioned to adjourn; Mr. Scanlon seconded. The motion to adjourn passed 5-0. Mr. Miles adjourned the meeting.
