

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, EXTENDING APPRECIATION TO MICHAEL NASH FOR SERVING AS WARD FIVE COUNCILMEMBER IN NORMAN, OKLAHOMA.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the health and well-being of a democratic society depends on the active participation of citizens in the affairs of the government; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the level of government which is closest to the people is that of City government; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, those individuals who seek to run for public office at the municipal level do so out of deep caring and concern for the future of their community and bring their own unique talents, values, and abilities to the job; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, those individuals who are elected take on the responsibility to establish public policy and to meet the challenge of complex issues and problems to the best of their abilities; and

- § 6. WHEREAS, Michael Nash served on the City Council representing Ward Five in an interim capacity from September 8, 2020, until July 6, 2021, to fill the remainder of the term created by a vacancy; and
- § 7. WHEREAS, although his time on Council was short his dedication to communication with his constituents and researching and studying the materials presented to Council for action or input is to be commended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 8. That the Council of the City of Norman, on behalf of the entire citizenry of Norman, commends and extends appreciation to Michael Nash for his service to this community as Councilmember for Ward Five and wish him well in his future endeavors.
