A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA SUPPORTING THE ABSENTEE SHAWNEE TRIBE'S PURSUIT OF TRIBAL TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM SAFETY FUNDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS ALONG TTP ROUTES 72ND AVENUE SE, 168TH AVENUE NE, AND 156TH AVENUE NE.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the Absentee Shawnee Tribe ("AST") maintains a federal Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) with the United States Department of the Interior.
- § 2. WHEREAS, through its TTP, the AST has opportunities to obtain Tribal Transportation Program Safety Funds ("TTPSF"), which are to be used to improve roadways within the AST's National Tribal Transportation Facility Inventory ("NTTFI").
- § 3. WHEREAS, concurrent with this Resolution, the City Council has approved a Memorandum of Understanding acknowledging its authority pursuant to 25 CFR 170.446(g) so that 72nd Street SE is added to the NTTFI, and so that TTPSF may be made available to AST for the installation of safety countermeasures along this route.
- § 4. WHEREAS, the AST, if awarded TTPSF funds, would work with the City of Norman regarding the purchase, permitting and installation of said safety improvements, all in compliance with applicable regulations, including those of the City of Norman.
- § 5. WHEREAS, the AST has proposed safety improvements to various intersections on 72nd Street SE and 168th Avenue NE as well as a segment of 156th Avenue NE within Norman municipal limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, AS FOLLOWS:

- § 6. The City of Norman supports the Absentee Shawnee Tribe in pursuit of the TTPSF for 72nd Street SE, 168th Avenue NE, and 156th Avenue NE.
- § 7. Should the Absentee Shawnee Tribe be awarded the funds for this safety project, the City of Norman will support the installation and maintenance of the safety countermeasures.
