

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, REQUESTING THE TOBACCO SETTLEMENT ENDOWMENT TRUST (TSET) CONSIDER THE CITY OF NORMAN'S PROJECT TO DESIGN ONE MILE OF MULTI-MODAL PATH ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF STATE HIGHWAY 9 BETWEEN 84TH AVENUE SE AND 96TH AVENUE SE FOR THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT GRANTS.

- § 1. WHEREAS, Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust's (TSET) Built Environment Grants have been made available to strengthen local efforts to create healthier environments; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Norman has selected a project to design one mile of multi-modal path along the north side of State Highway 9 between 84th Avenue SE and 96th Avenue SE; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the City of Norman is requesting a \$150,000 Planning Grant for the consultant services necessary to prepare proper construction plans; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, no City funds are committed by this action; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Norman to expedite the preparation and submission of an application for financial assistance from the TSET Built Environment Grants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 6. That the City Manager of the City of Norman, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to sign an application and related documentation necessary to file and process a grant application through the TSET Built Environment Grant on behalf of the City of Norman; and
- § 7. That the Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust is hereby requested to consider this project as a candidate for the Built Environment Grant funding for approval.
