

A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY
OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING THE
MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2025, AS NATIONAL
BULLYING PREVENTION MONTH IN THE CITY OF
NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, during the first week of October, 2006, PACER's National Bullying Prevention Center initiated National Bullying Prevention and Awareness Week to raise awareness about bullying; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the campaign expanded in 2010 from one week to an entire month and was re-named Bullying Prevention Month; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the purpose of Bullying Prevention Month is to educate, provide awareness, and change the culture around bullying, which was historically considered a childhood rite of passage but now is known to cause school avoidance, decreased self-esteem, depression, and even self-harm; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, bullying can include physical, verbal, sexual, or emotional harm or intimidation intentionally directed at a person or group of people; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, students who experience bullying are at an increased risk for poor school adjustment, sleep difficulties, anxiety, and depression; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, children who bully are at greater risk of engaging in more serious violent behaviors; and
- § 7. WHEREAS, children who witness bullying often feel less secure, more fearful, and intimidated.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 8. Do hereby proclaim the month of October, 2025, as Bullying Prevention Month in the City of Norman and encourage all citizens to engage in a variety of awareness and prevention activities designed to make our community safer for all children and adolescents.
