

A RESOLUTION OF THE NORMAN UTILITIES  
AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR  
EMERGENCY GRANT FROM THE OKLAHOMA WATER  
RESOURCES BOARD FOR PROJECT WW0212, BISHOP  
CREEK EMERGENCY SEWER LINE REPAIR.

- § 1. WHEREAS, an emergency exists by virtue of the Emergency Declaration executed by Norman's City Manager on May 19, 2025, as ratified by Norman City Council at their June 10, 2025, meeting, arising from the failure of an 18" sanitary sewer aerial crossing in the general vicinity of 730 Stinson Street due to flooding of Bishop Creek; which justifies an emergency grant application; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Norman Utilities Authority has been forced to reallocate limited funding from other critical capital improvement needs in order to complete repairs necessitated by this emergency, which could, in time, threaten the public health and welfare of the people of the City of Norman; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Norman to expedite the preparation and submission of an application for financial assistance from the Oklahoma Water Resources Board in the form of a grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA AND THE TRUSTEES OF THE NORMAN UTILITIES AUTHORITY:

- § 4. Based on the emergency as declared relating to the 18" diameter sanitary sewer aerial crossing of Bishop Creek, the Norman Utilities Authority hereby authorizes and directs the General Manager or his designee to sign an application and related documents necessary to file and process a grant application with the Oklahoma Water Resources Board on behalf of Norman Utilities Authority.
