#### **ATTACHMENT A**

#### SCOPE OF SERVICES

The following language added to Attachment B of the Agreement:

#### Task 4.0 - Construction Phase Services

- Davis Bacon Review
  - Garver will review weekly certified payrolls through the normal construction schedule for completeness by verifying that it meets prevailing wages outlined in the conformed documents.
  - o Garver will not verify laborers have been onsite.
  - o Garver will not conduct labor interviews.

#### Task 6.0 - Construction Observation Services

In addition to services listed in Task 4.0, part-time construction observation is included. Construction observation services will supplement construction administration and provide or accomplish the following:

- Provide part-time construction observation services for the construction contract performance time. The
  proposed fee is on a maximum of 150 hours of inspection during the construction contract performance time.
- Consult with and advise the Owner during the construction period.
- Maintain a working knowledge of the construction progress.
- · Coordinate potential plan changes to the original construction documents.

In performing construction observation services, Garver will endeavor to protect the Owner against defects and deficiencies in the work of the Contractor(s); but Garver cannot guarantee the performance of the Contractor(s), nor be responsible for the actual supervision of construction operations or for the safety measures that the Contractor(s) takes or should take. However, if at any time during construction Garver observes that the Contractor's work does not comply with the construction contract documents, Garver will notify the appropriate for the situation. Garver will also record the observance, the discussion, and the action taken. If the Contractor continues without satisfactory corrective action, Garver will notify the Owner immediately, so that appropriate action under the Owner's contract with the Contractor can be taken.
