

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, CLOSING A PORTION OF A PLATTED SIX-FOOT (6') UTILITY EASEMENT WITHIN A PORTION OF LOT 15, ALL OF LOTS 16 THROUGH 29 AND A PORTION OF LOT 30, BLOCK 4, HARDIE-RUCKER ADDITION, A SIMPLE PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT, TO NORMAN, CLEVELAND COUNTY, OKLAHOMA; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 1. That, pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, the owner of the subject property, North American Islamic Trust, through Islamic Center of Norman, has petitioned the City to partially close a platted six-foot (6') utility easement located within a portion of Lot 15, all of Lots 16 through 29, and a portion of Lot 30, Block 4, HARDIE-RUCKER ADDITION, a Simple Planned Unit Development; and,
- § 2. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, the proper notice has been given, and the maps, memorandums and other items required by said Resolution have been presented to this Council; and
- § 3. That, also pursuant to Resolution Number R-8182-66, a public hearing has been held by the Planning Commission on April 9, 2026, regarding said closing; and
- § 4. That, a part of the platted six-foot (6') utility easement within a portion of Lot Fifteen (15), all of Lots Sixteen (16) through Twenty-Nine (29) and a portion of Lot Thirty (30), Block Four (4) of HARDIE-RUCKER ADDITION, a Simple Planned Unit Development, Norman, Cleveland County, Oklahoma, is hereby closed, notwithstanding Cox Communications, Inc. and Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company's reservations and objections.
- § 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
