The below referenced terms hereby amend Contract Agreement <u>R1-2022-NORMAN</u> between the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments and the City of Norman dated the 21st day of March 2022.

The stated contract is for the provision of reimbursement of certain costs incurred for the purchase of two (2) dual DC fast charging stations as further defined in the above referenced contract, A.2.b.

May it be known that the undersigned parties do hereby agree to make the following changes and/or additions outlined below. These changes and/or additions shall be held valid as if included in the original contract referenced above.

Paragraph A, Section A.2.b. and Paragraph C, Section C.4.a. and C.4.b shall be amended to extend the term of Part I and Part II as follows:

A. SCOPE OF SERVICES

A.2.b. Funds are intended to defray the costs related to the three (3) "Beam Solar" level 2 EV charging stations.

C. PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- C.4.a. All invoices for reimbursement must be received by ACOG no later than **March 1, 2026** to include only expenses incurred during the period delineated as Part I of Contract Terms.
- C.4.b. The Grantee's failure to provide an invoice to ACOG by **March 1, 2026**, as required, shall result in the Grantee being deemed ineligible for reimbursement under this Grant Contract, and any and all financial and legal liabilities related to the awarded project shall be upon the Grantee and not the responsibility or liability of ACOG No other terms or conditions of the above referenced contract shall be negated or changed as a result of this Addendum
