DISCUSSION:

The Westwood Golf Course was designed in 1967 by golf architect Floyd Farley and later redesigned by Tripp Davis in 2003. The 6,200-yard course was recently renovated and features wide, tree-lined fairways and gently contoured greens, twenty (20) traps and several water hazards. The challenging, yet playable, course is perfect for the weekend golfer or the advanced competitor. Open year-round, Westwood is well-known throughout the metropolitan area as an excellent municipal golf course that consistently offers exceptional greens.

Along with the course itself, the facility features an on-site driving range (featuring "Lunch and Launch" on weekdays), practice putting and chipping greens, a clubhouse, a golf shop, a restaurant, and an outdoor scoreboard with an adjoining patio. Rates are affordable and tee times and professional lessons are both available daily. Every year, the course hosts The Westwood Invitational, a 3-day, 54-hole stroke-play tournament that usually takes place around July 4th. It is one of the state's largest and longest running tournaments.

DISCUSSION:

Westwood Golf and Golf Maintenance gave its annual presentation to the Board of Park Commissioners on August 6, 2026. Their presentation included information about their events, programming, and rentals.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council accept Westwood Golf and Golf Maintenance's annual report for the 2025 calendar year.
