

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN,  
OKLAHOMA, REQUESTING THAT THE ASSOCIATION OF  
CENTRAL OKLAHOMA GOVERNMENTS CONSIDER THE  
SELECTION OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF TEN (10) NEW BUS  
STOPS, AS A PROJECT CANDIDATE FOR FEDERAL FUNDING  
UNDER THE ACOG AIR QUALITY SMALL GRANT PROGRAM.**

- § 1. WHEREAS, the ACOG Air Quality Small Grant Program is funded with Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program and Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) funds for urbanized areas and have been made available for transportation improvements within the ACOG Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) area; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Norman has selected an eligible improvement project described as follows:
- Construction of Ten (10) New Bus Stops associated with the  
Recommended Route Network in the Go Norman Transit Plan;**  
and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the preliminary estimate of total construction cost is \$52,827.83 and Federal participation under the terms of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) relating to Transportation Alternatives Program funds is hereby requested for funding 75% of the project cost, which is estimated at \$39,620.87; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the City of Norman will prepare detailed plans, specifications, and estimates; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, the City of Norman agrees to provide satisfactory maintenance after completion, to furnish the necessary right-of-way clear and unobstructed, and to relocate any utilities required/affected by this project; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, the City has the required matching funds available and further agrees to deposit matching funds by separate agreement with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) prior to advertising of the project for bid by ODOT; and
- § 7. WHEREAS, the City agrees, as a condition to receiving any Federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation, that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42. U.S.C. 2000d et seq., and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, "Nondiscrimination of Federally-Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation-Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964";and
- § 8. WHEREAS, the City assures that no qualified person with a disability shall, solely by reasons of their disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity administered by the City; and

§ 9. WHEREAS, the City further understands that acceptance of this resolution by the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments (ACOG) and the Oklahoma Department of Transportation is not a commitment to Federal funding, but only registers the City's interest and intent in participating in the program application process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN:

§ 10. That the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments is hereby requested to consider the selection of this project as a candidate for Federal funding, and to submit the same to the Oklahoma Transportation Commission for its approval.

§ 11. That the Oklahoma Transportation Commission is hereby requested to concur in the selection of this project and to submit same to the Federal Highway Administration for its approval in the selection and approval of this project for construction.
