

A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF APRIL 12-18, 2026, AS NATIONAL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT WEEK IN THE CITY OF NORMAN.

- § 1. WHEREAS, the week of April 12-18, 2026, has been designated as National Community Development Week to celebrate the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Programs (HOME); and
- § 2. WHEREAS, the CDBG and HOME Programs provide annual funding and flexibility to local communities to provide decent, safe and affordable housing, a suitable living environment, and economic opportunities to low- and moderate-income people; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, over the past five years, our community has received a total of \$4,712,761 in CDBG and \$2,101,089 of HOME Investment Partnership funds and has funded a variety of projects that have directly benefited our citizens and neighborhoods; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, the CDBG and HOME Programs are a versatile funding source that helps us revitalize our neighborhoods and improve our citizens' lives. Locally, every \$1 of these funding sources leverages \$4 in additional private investment. Countless projects within Norman would not have been possible without these federal investments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- § 5. THAT the City of Norman designates the week of April 12- 18, 2026 as National Community Development Week in support of these valuable programs that has made tremendous contributions to the viability of the housing stock, infrastructure, public services, and the economic well-being of our community.
