Dear City of Norman Partners,

The future of Norman should be built by the people who love it most – local entrepreneurs deeply invested in their neighborhoods. We're introducing a partnership opportunity that directly supports the City's priorities: affordable housing, sustainable growth, and livability as outlined in AIM Norman.

The Incremental Development Alliance, in partnership with local housing advocates, is hosting a small developer bootcamp that trains emerging local developers to create community-building projects while generating wealth-building opportunities in their neighborhoods. This program directly supports Norman's progressive housing initiatives, including 2021 parking reform that replaced "Spaces Required" with "Spaces Recommended" and AIM Norman's strategy to remove single-unit-only zoning.

This partnership positions Norman as a national model for innovative community economic development while building local capacity to implement AIM Norman's goals for 23,200 new homes by 2045 with trained neighborhood developers who understand community needs.

IncDev's proven model has trained nearly 9,000 developers across 33 states. As our partner, the City gains access to program graduates who will implement Norman's housing vision – trained developers with completed pro formas, investor-ready pitch decks, and projects that align with AIM Norman's affordable housing strategies.

Norman's parking mandate elimination and AIM Norman's infill development focus create immediate opportunities for missing middle housing. The City will be recognized as the municipal leader that empowers locals to build wealth through real estate development while achieving measurable progress on housing diversity.
