NORMAN TRANSIT CENTER

- The Norman Transit Center opened in October 2023.
- Wastewater lines replaced and grinder pump installed later October to early December 2023.
 - Decay in iron wastewater pipes led to rusting and flaking, causing debris to be caught which resulted in flooding.
- Issues with the restroom continued, mostly revolving around items (clothing, etc.) getting caught in the pipe and causing flooding.
- Facility Maintenance installed a new type of toilet on June 2025.
- Currently, the lobby and restroom are closed due to the lobby door being inoperable. The City is awaiting a vendor to make a repair.
- When open, the restroom is available for public use from 10am-6pm. This
 coincides with when security, provided by a third-party contractor through our
 EMBARK contract, is on site.




