

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, APPROPRIATING \$2,500,000 FROM THE 2021 STREET MAINTENANCE BOND FUND BALANCE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO ROBINSON STREET FROM LOMA DRIVE TO CANTERBURY STREET, AND EAST INTERSTATE DRIVE FROM ROBINSON STREET TO ROCK CREEK ROAD; AND ADDING PROJECT LOCATIONS TO THE STREET MAINTENANCE BOND.

- § 1. WHEREAS, in 2021, Norman residents voted to approve the 2021-2026 Street Maintenance General Obligation (GO) Bond Program that operates on a five-year cycle; and
- § 2. WHEREAS the Street Maintenance GO Bond Program funds the resurfacing, rehabilitation and reconstruction of neighborhood streets; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, all final project locations under the original bond program are currently under construction and there have been savings accumulated which will allow the City to consider additional project locations; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, Staff from the Public Works Division have identified two additional locations that meet the program requirements and preliminary costs have been generated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 5. THAT the following be appropriated for the reasons stated above.
