

A PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY
OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, PROCLAIMING THE
MONTH OF DECEMBER, 2025, AS UNIVERSAL
HUMAN RIGHTS MONTH IN THE CITY OF NORMAN

- § 1. WHEREAS, each December, communities across the nation and around the world observe Universal Human Rights Month, a time dedicated to promoting dignity, equality, and rights inherent to every individual; and
- § 2. WHEREAS, Human Rights Day, observed annually on December 10, commemorates the historic adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights by the United Nations General Assembly on December 10, 1948, an enduring symbol of global commitment to justice and human dignity; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, the City of Norman Human Rights Commission, as established under Norman City Code, promotes education and awareness of the rights protected in the City's civil rights ordinance, receives and seeks resolution of written discrimination complaints, and works collaboratively with residents and city government, to continue to build Norman as an inclusive community; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, this month and this day remind us of our shared responsibility to uphold human rights, foster respect for all people.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 5. Do hereby proclaim the month of December, 2025, as Universal Human Rights Month and encourage all residents of Norman to reflect on the importance of human rights and to support efforts that advance equality, justice, and compassion for all.
